Turf - we have had some insect activity that is continually treated as needed. Turf weeds are germinating due to copious amounts of rain fall and will be sprayed again in September. Turf replacements will be made as needed.

Shrubs - overall in good health. We will continually remove declining Hawthorne.

Palms - we removed another Washingtonian Palm at the gate and will continually monitor their condition.

Irrigation - no major issues. We will determine what repairs need to be made (if any) after the sewer repair is completed on Natalie way.
