Turf - the turf in the center median, exiting the community was replaced at no charge to the association and is doing well. We have experienced some insect activity but it has been treated

Shrubs - The Hawthorne continue to decline and we will remove specific areas and will be installing st augustine in their place.

Palms - seem to be good health. There have not been any Washingtonian removed this month. We will continually monitor their condition. The Queens on the south side of the property were fertilized and begin to show signs of recovery.

Irrigation - The irrigation is operating properly and running 2 days a week. A main line repair was made Monday the 27th leading to the marina.
