June 2017 Landscape Report

Turf – The rains have started and begun to release the fertilizer. The turf is recovering nicely from the drought stress. Unfortunately, the rains have covered the sod fields in water. The sod that is being cut is waterlogged and full of fungus. So, I have delayed turf replenishments within the community.

Shrubs – The Hawthorne are continuing to decline due to Pythium root rot. We will remove as necessary.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will let the board know if there are any that need to be removed.

Irrigation – Minor repairs have been made with the monthly inspections.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
