

Harbourage at Braden River CDD- Landscape Report for May 2016

Good morning,

Turf - the turf in the center median, exiting the community, suffered damage due to drought and insect damage. It will be replaced at N/C to the community. The turf was fertilized on the 25th of April and will not be fertilized again until October due to a mandated moratorium. Our insecticide application was applied on the 18th of April.

Shrubs - The Hawthorne continue to decline and we will remove as necessary.

Palms - We had to remove a Washingtonian palm the week of May 16th and will monitor the remaining Washis for damage.

Irrigation - The irrigation is operating properly and running 2 days a week. Hopefully we will start to see some relief from the dry season with regular chances of rain on the way.

Thank you and we will continue to work together to maintain a constantly evolving landscape.
