

## Harborage at Braden River CDD May 2017 Landscape Report

*Turf* – Turf fertility was applied 5/31. Turf replenishments will begin this month with higher chances of rain.

Shrubs – The Hawthorne are continuing to decline due to Pythium root rot. We will remove as necessary. Shrub fertility was applied with the turf.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will do my best to let the board know if there are any that need to be removed. Palm micro-nutrients will be applied in June.

*Irrigation* – We replaced the irrigation timer at the front gate. We will also be re-programming all timers to reflect the water restrictions in place.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
