Turf – Turf holding color with the time release application made in May. Very little chinch bug activity and insecticide applications to be made as necessary. We will also be looking for fungus in the turf with the all the rainfall.

Shrubs – We have seen very rapid growth rates this month with fertility applied in May, as well as, substantial rainfall and heat. Our men are working diligently to keep with the growth rates.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will do my best to let the board know if there are any that need to be removed.

Trees – We provided a quote to remove the diseased Oak on Duvall.

Irrigation – Inspections continue with little repairs/problems. And the rain certainly helps.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
