Turf – Turf holding color with the time release application made in May. Very little chinch bug activity and insecticide applications to be made as necessary. We will also be looking for fungus in the turf with the all the rainfall. We will be replacing the turf in the dog park area within the first two weeks in September.

Shrubs – We have seen very rapid growth rates this month, as well as, substantial rainfall and heat. Our men are working diligently to keep with the growth rates.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will do my best to let the board know if there are any that need to be removed.

Trees – Tree canopies will be lifted in October up to 10' over roadways and sidewalks.

Irrigation – Inspections continue with little repairs/problems. And the rain certainly helps.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
