Turf – Very little chinch bug activity and insecticide applications to be made as necessary. The dog park was prepped for sod but the installation was delayed due to Hurricane Irma.

Shrubs – We have seen very rapid growth rates this month, as well as, substantial rainfall and heat. Our men are working diligently to keep with the growth rates. We will be removing dense plantings in the first few weeks of October. Originally scheduled for September, again was delayed due Irma.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will do my best to let the board know if there are any that need to be removed.

Trees – Tree canopies will be lifted in October up to 10' over roadways and sidewalks.

Irrigation – Inspections continue with little repairs/problems.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
