

Harbourage at Braden River CDD Monthly Report *January 2016*

Turf – Good Condition. We fertilized the turf on Wednesday the 20th.

Shrubs – The Hawthorne are continuing to decline due to Pythium root rot. We will remove as necessary. Otherwise in good health. We will be fertilizing the shrubs in February. We will be cutting back the flowering shrubs starting in late February.

Palms – We will continue to monitor the Washingtonia palms. I will do my best to let the board know if there are any that need to be removed.

Irrigation – There have been a few issues with irrigation but nothing too major. We found 2 irrigation zones not communicating with the timer. 1 zone in the turf island south of the entrance on Natalie way and the small section of turf between the sidewalk and the road leading into the entrance.

We look forward to working together in maintaining a constantly evolving landscape.
